**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF LAMBERT CONSTRUCTION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO ALLEY RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH BETWEEN MAIN AND MAPLE STREETS, 4<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO 5<sup>TH</sup> STREET; APPROVING CRAFTON-TULL-SPARKS ENGINEERS AS CONSTRUCTION INSPECTORS; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of North Little Rock advertised for bids for Alley Improvements between Main and Maple Streets, 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street (see Bid Summary No. 09-2915 attached hereto as Exhibit "A"); and

WHEREAS, Lambert Construction was the lowest bidder with a bid of \$126,879.50 for Phase I of the project; and

WHEREAS, Crafton-Tull-Sparks Engineers prepared design plans for the project, is the proper firm for construction inspection, and has agreed to perform the inspection work for a fee of \$5,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the low bid submitted by Lambert Construction for improvements to the alley running north and south between Main and Maple Streets, 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, in the amount of \$126,879.50, is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: That Crafton-Tull-Sparks Engineers, designer of the construction project, is hereby approved to be construction inspector for a fee of \$5,000.00.

SECTION 3: That the amounts of \$126,879.50 for work performed by Lambert Construction and \$5,000.00 for construction inspection by Crafton-Tull-Sparks Engineers are hereby appropriated from the Special Projects Capitol Improvements Fund.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
