RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2006 AND 2010 ANNUAL ACTION PLANS OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK IN REGARD TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Little Rock (“the City”) submitted a 2006 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development on December 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City is amending its 2006 plan to expand the description of the Community Housing Resource Board Project activity to include the hiring of a consultant to prepare the City’s Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing document; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted a 2010 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development on November 15, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City is amending its 2010 plan to delete the High Street Drainage and Street Improvement Project from MacArthur Drive to Sunset Drive in the amount of \$85,000, include the 47th Street Drainage Project and the surrounding area in the amount of \$85,000, and add the Project Weatherization in the amount of \$40,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the 2006 and 2010 Annual Action Plans are amended pursuant to Exhibits “A” and “B” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: That the description of the Community Housing Resource Board activity will be expanded to include the hiring of a consultant to prepare the City’s Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing document outlined in Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

SECTION 3: That the \$85,000 from the High Street Drainage and Street Improvement Project will be allocated to the 47th Street Drainage Project and \$40,000 will be allocated to the Weatherization Project as outlined in Exhibit “B” attached hereto.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
